SEVERE WEATHER EMERGENCY POLICY

(Revised August 2017)

In the event of severe weather, the following policy is in effect:

- The open/close status of St. Matthew will be communicated to staff and parishioners by the following methods of communications – website, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, parish app, Constant Contact e-blast, local television stations inclement weather ticker, and inclement weather notification on parish telephone number (ext. 1096). The communication will be specific as to whether the closure will impact daily mass schedule, staff attendance, Faith Formation classes, meetings, rehearsals, athletic activities, classes and workshops, and support groups.
- In the event St. Matthew is closed, staff is <u>not</u> authorized to open the facility for any event, class, meeting, rehearsal or activity unless specifically approved by the pastor.
- The <u>pastor or designated administration individual</u> will determine if early release is necessary during severe weather.
- If you find yourself unable to leave the campus due to severe weather, specifically hurricane and/or tornado, safe places on the campus are:

All restrooms
Employee lunchroom and lounge (Bride's Room)

Remember to seek shelter in interior rooms without windows.

- In the event of an emergency and the Parish Center and New Life Center Banquet Room are unaffected, these areas will be offered as shelter and all activities will be cancelled until the emergency has been lifted. The aforementioned facilities will be utilized as a Natural or Man-Made Disaster Shelter by the American Red Cross.
- The campus is equipped with multiple first aide kits and blood-borne pathogen kits; locations are as follows:

Parish Center lobby
Altar servers/Ushers room in narthex
Employee lunchroom in Sanctuary building
First floor of New Life Center near elevator
Second floor of New Life Center near elevator

 The main campus is equipped with five AED's (Automated External Defibrillators); locations are as follows:

Narthex Lobby between Adoration Chapel and Daily Mass Chapel First floor of New Life Center near elevator Parish Center lobby First floor of Education Center opposite cafeteria

 South Campus is equipped with one AED which is located just off the main lobby in the classroom hallway. First aid kits and blood-borne pathogen kits are located in the kitchen, nursery, main hallway and side hallway.
