# The Journey of Faith Adult Education Scholarship Jeremiah 29:11

#### **Purpose of Scholarship:**

- 1. Support adults who are returning to school to pursue careers that serve others.
- 2. Support and thank adults for their active involvement at St. Matthew.
- 3. Encourage adult students to continue in their Catholic faith.

### **Scholarship Awards:**

- 1. One \$5000 scholarships to be awarded each year.
- 2. \$2500 will be awarded before the start of an adult student's first year returning to school and the remaining \$2500 after the student completes their second full year.
- 3. The second installment of \$2500 will be awarded after the adult student completes his/her second year of college/graduate school/technical school following confirmation of ongoing active participation at St. Matthew or a Catholic parish/campus community, student in good standing, and vocation consistent with criteria established for the scholarship (item #3 below).

## **Scholarship Criteria:**

- 1. Adults registered at St. Matthew.
- 2. Adults who are active in ministry programs at St. Matthew
- 3. Adult student intends to pursue a degree/vocation in health care, teaching, youth ministry, social work, military, or priesthood/ religious life.
- 4. St. Matthew staff members are eligible.

#### **Process to Apply and Due Dates**

- 1. Adult students must submit the application by <u>March 31, 2019</u> electronically to journey@stmatthewcatholic.org or by hard copy to the church office in an envelope marked "The Journey of Faith Adult Scholarship".
- 2. The Selection Committee will review the applications and identify a winner. The Selection Committee, at its discretion, may identify several finalists and conduct interviews to discern a winner. Interviews, if required, will take place in May.
- 3. The Selection Committee will recommend the winner to the Pastor.
- 4. The winner will be notified promptly (target May 1). Adult students who are not selected will also be notified at this time.
- 5. The selection committee consists of three people from the Faith Formation staff, one deacon of St. Matthew, and one member of the Parish Community.
