**DATE:** Feb. 13    **TIME:** 10 am to 8:30 pm

**LOCATION:** Camp Thunderbird (1 Thunderbird Lane, Lake Wylie SC)

- Transportation will not be provided by St. Matthew. Participants must be dropped off and picked up at the camp. Participants may not drive themselves, as parking will not be available.

## **DETAILS:**

- **REGISTRATION:** Form will go live on Tuesday, Jan. 26 at 9 am.
  - Cost is \$50 for each participant (financial assistance is available, just contact [Lauren](#)).
  - Retreat is limited to 60 participants.
- **FACILITY:** We are hopeful that we will have great weather and plan to hold most of the retreat outdoors. Otherwise, we have the largest hall reserved at Camp Thunderbird to account for social distancing.
- **SAFETY:** All participants, including teens and adults, are required to wear a mask covering their mouth and nose, for the entirety of the event and maintain safe, social distance from each other. This is required by both St. Matthew and Camp Thunderbird.
  - Temperature checks will be taken by Camp Thunderbird staff upon arrival, in addition to a symptom question assessment.
- **FOOD:** Meals will be provided, and are individually pre-packaged. If you have special dietary needs, please let [Lauren](#) know as soon as possible. Teens will be asked to bring their own water bottles, and pre-packaged snacks will be made available during the day.
