If Choir is singing the chaplet, please come forward for veneration of the St. Faustina relic. If reciting the chaplet, veneration will be after praying the chaplet.

Presider: You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls,

and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world.

O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us. (Diary 1319)

All: O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus

as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You! (repeat 3 times)

Presider: Our Father, who are in Heaven, hallowed be thy name.

Thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven.

All: Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our trespasses

as we forgive those who trespass against us;

and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Presider: Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you.

Blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

All: Holy Mary, Mother of God,

pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen

Presider: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth;

and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead.

All: Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion – inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Prayer to the Divine Mercy

All:

O Lord, behold here before You a soul who exists in this world in order to allow You to exercise Your admirable mercy and manifest it before heaven and earth.
